Tournament Rules:

- This is a doubles 9-Pin-No-Tap Tournament (1 Adult & 1 Youth) for all present FM USBC youth members & 1 adult bowler. (The adult may be sanctioned with another association other than Fargo-Moorhead, so that could mean grandparents, aunts or uncles from somewhere else, as long as the youth is a member of FM USBC). Non-USBC adult members may bowl with a youth member in the E division.
- Entries close at the beginning of the final shift of the tournament. **Pre-registration is required or a walk-in fee of \$5.00 will be charged per person. Walk-ins are accepted based on lane availability.**
- Averages - Bowlers must use their highest book average from the previous season. If they didn't bowl the previous season, they must use their highest current average of at least 12 games or more as of the date they bowl this tournament. This must be verified by their coach or secretary. If anyone does not have a last year's average or hasn't bowled at least 12 games this season on a sanctioned league they will use their current high league average as of the date bowled at the discretion of the tournament director. An adult with less than 12 games will bowl scratch using an average of 200. Rule #319a2 will be waived. Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average. Use of invalid averages will result in disqualifications and forfeiture of entry fee. Division E adult bowlers will use an average of 200.
- Handicap will be 100% of the difference from 400 per team.
- Entrants may enter as many time as they want, but must have a different partner each time. Each member of each team will bowl a 3-game series.
- Awards will be given on a 1 out of 4 basis in each division. All prizes will be returned as scholarships. For each team placing there will be one certificate with both partners names on it and given to the Your Bowler. Certificates will be presented at the Fargo-Moorhead Youth Banquet. (Rule #319d does not apply).
- SPECIAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS:** \$100 Scholarships will be awarded to one boy and girl youth bowler in the following divisions. Bowlers who bowl multiple times, will be entered each time, however, the highest score will be counted towards the scholarship. Handicap will be figured 100% of 200. Scholarships will be handled through SMART #09875. Class A: 160 & Over; Class B: 135 - 159; Class C: 110 - 134; Class D: 80 - 109; Class E: 79 & Below. Scholarships donated by FM USBC.
- A maximum of 3 teams of contestants will be scheduled on each lane. Lanes will be assigned by the tournament manager.
- The FM USBC Board of Directors shall decide any questions not covered by these rules.
- All electronic devices and cell phones MUST BE TURNED OFF during tournament play. Disqualification may be at the discretion of the tournament manager. Alcoholic beverages are NOT allowed.
- All bowlers shall be neat, clean and dressed in an appropriate manner. All bowlers shall be dressed modestly and should not reveal one's undergarments. Clothing with inappropriate language or gestures shall not be worn. No caps or headgear shall be worn. Any matters not covered, shall be handled by the tournament manager. It is the responsibility of both the parents/guardians and the youth bowlers to see that this dress code is followed.
- This tournament is not certified with USBC but will use USBC rules.
