FM USBC YOUTH ALL-CITY TOURNAMENT RULES

1. All participants must be a FM USBC Association Member. No participation cards will be issued.
2. Highest average as of November 20, 2022. Tournament Manager's discretion for less than 12 games minimum. FM USBC Association sanctioned averages only. No averages or leagues related to traveling teams or High School qualify - use of invalid averages will result in disqualifications and forfeiture of entry fee.
3. **Please make reservations early!** Entries close at the beginning of the final shift of the tournament. **Pre-registration is required or a walk-in fee of \$5.00 will be charged per person. Walk-ins are accepted based on lane availability.** Additional shifts added if necessary
4. GENERAL AWARDS: Awards will be based on one out of every four entries in team event, doubles event, and singles event.
5. Subs are permitted but must take the place of the original entrant's position in the line-up.
6. All coaches or supervisors will make available a copy of all youth league average sheets to the FM USBC Association Manager in advance of the youth city tournament.
7. HANDICAP: Shall be based on 90% of 220. Individual handicap per event. Handicap shall be based on averages instead of ages in all divisions.
8. Divisions shall be as follows:

TEAM EVENT: 4 member team - may be all boys, all girls or mixed

DOUBLES EVENT: May be both boys, both girls or a boy/girl

SINGLES EVENT: Will be separate boys and girls divisions

ALL EVENTS: The total of your 1st team score, doubles and singles scores.

10. MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION: Events will be Team, Doubles, Singles. Doubles and singles in the same shift must be bowled in sequence, but you can bowl just doubles or just singles. A bowler bowling doubles twice must change partners for the second appearance. If a bowler places more than once in singles, they are only awarded once (the higher finish). A bowler may participate two times in Team with the change of at least 2 Team members. First Appearance in any event counts towards all-events.
11. ENTRY FEE IS \$20.00 PER EVENT: That means it costs \$20.00 to bowl team event, \$20.00 to bowl doubles and \$20.00 to bowl singles for a total fee of \$60.00

12. SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS: The Fargo-Moorhead USBC Association will award a \$50 scholarship to the boy and girl Scratch All-Event Winner and boy and girl Handicap All-Event Winner. This will be paid through SMART account #09875. Total Scholarship awarded = \$200

13. SPECIAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS: \$25 scholarships will be awarded for each bowler with the top scratch and handicap scores in team event, doubles event, and boys and girls singles event. These scholarships are donated by the FM USBC. This will be paid through SMART account #09875. Total Scholarship Awarded = \$350

14. DRESS CODE: All bowlers shall be neat, clean and dressed in an appropriate manner. All bowlers shall be dressed modestly and should not reveal one's undergarments. Clothing with inappropriate language or gestures shall not be worn. No caps or headgear shall be worn. Any matters not covered, shall be handled by the tournament manager. It is the responsibility of both the parents/guardians and the youth bowler to see that this dress code is followed.
15. ELECTRONIC DEVICES: All electronic devices and cell phones MUST BE TURNED OFF during tournament play. Disqualification may be at the discretion of the tournament manager.
16. There is no alcohol allowed during the youth bowling tournament shifts.
