FM USBC All-City Tournament TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Tournament will consist of Team, Doubles, Singles, and All Events in both Open and Women's Divisions. Open Team is a 5-person team. Women's Team is a 4-person team. Entry fees are \$40.00 per person in Team, Doubles & Singles. The optional Handicap All-Events fee is \$5.00. The optional Scratch All-Events fee is \$10.00.
2. Eligibility: All members of the FM USBC Association are eligible to enter. All members must have a prior year average or current year average with 21 games in the Association prior to the start of the tournament to be eligible to participate. Membership is not available for purchase at tournament site.
3. Contestants may bowl the doubles and singles event only twice per division. You must enter both of these events or neither. A participant may bowl up to two sets of doubles by changing partners. Entrants bowling doubles twice will also bowl singles twice and be able to place twice in the prize fund. First appearance in the doubles and singles events will count towards their All Events scores. Contestants may bowl the team event under the following conditions: A) Teams must change two (2) bowlers to compete in more than one team event. B) Bowlers who bowl more than once in the team event will use their first team score all-events.
4. The optional Handicap All-Events fee of \$5.00 must be prepaid with your first entry. Payoff is 1 for 8. 100% returned as prizes.
5. The optional Scratch All-Events fee is \$10.00. Payoff is 1 for 8. 100% returned as prizes. *(Minimum of 6 entries to run this event. In the event that we don't have the entries, all entrants will receive a refund of paid entry)*
6. Team, Doubles and Singles payoff is 1 for 4. Champions in each division and each event will receive a jacket or cash equivalent.
7. Handicap will be 90% of the difference between the bowler's entering average and 220.
8. An entrant will use their highest USBC average of 21 games or more from the previous 3 seasons (2019/2020, 2020/2021, 2021/2022). If no previous league average, the entrant shall use the highest current league average of 12 games or more as of the opening date of the tournament. If current average is 10 pins or higher than the previous season average, the bowler will be required to use the higher of the two averages. An entrant is responsible for verifying the accuracy of the average. Rule 319E: A bowler shall adjust his/her entering average if, during the 12-month period immediately preceding the time and date of bowling, the bowler's accumulated average for all, but not less than 21 tournament games, exceeds the average to be used for entry by **10 or more pins**. In that case, the accumulated average must be used for handicapping or classification purposes. USBC Rule 319A, 319D, 319C and 201 will be enforced. Violation of these rules will result in disqualification.

10. Prize money will be added to the tournament based on the total number of participants in each division: 26-50: \$150.00, 51-75: \$225.00, 76-100: \$300.00, 101-125: \$375.00, 126-150: \$450.00, 151-175: \$525.00, 176 and up: \$600.

11. All bowlers should be aware of the USBC bowling ball specification rule (Chapter 8 Rule 6 B1 shall apply)
12. Errors in scoring must be reported to the scorekeepers or the tournament manager before the end of the game in which they occur. Except for obvious errors in addition, once the scores are transferred from the telescore to the recap sheet, they become final.
13. Entries close 30 minutes prior to the start of each shift. **Pre-registration is required or a walk-in fee of \$5.00 will be charged per person. Walk-ins are accepted based on lane availability.**
14. USBC Rule 322a: A player or team missing one or more frames by not being present and ready to bowl in turn shall: begin play with the score to count from the frame then being bowled and will receive zeros for any frames missed.
15. Additional squads may be added if deemed necessary by the tournament management.
16. Tournament Management reserves the right to reject any entrant whose conduct during the course of the tournament is deemed to be detrimental to the game of bowling.

NOTE: RULE NUMBERS REFERRED TO WITHIN THE GENERAL RULES OF THE TOURNAMENT ARE USBC RULES.

SPECIAL CASH PRIZES FOR THE HIGHEST TEAM, DOUBLES AND SINGLES SCORES BOWLED IN EACH DIVISION OF THE FIRST TWO WEEKENDS OF THE TOURNAMENT WILL BE AWARDED, PROVIDING A MINIMUM OF 4 ENTRANTS PER DIVISION IN THE EVENT BOWLED THAT WEEKEND.
