### Tournament Rules:

### USBC CERTIFIED

- One male and one female bowler per doubles team. Entry fee will be \$40.00 per person or \$80.00 per team.
- Eligibility: All members of the FM USBC Association are eligible to enter. All members must have a prior year average or current year average with 21 games in the Association prior to the start of the tournament to be eligible to participate. Membership is not available for purchase at tournament site.
- Multiple participation is allowed. You must change partners with every entry. You may not bowl with the same person more than once.
- Three (3) games will be bowled. Winner of the tournament will be determined by total score to the three (3) games, plus handicap. Handicap is based on 90% of 220. No limit.
- An entrant will use their highest USBC average of 21 games or more from the previous 3 seasons (2019/2020, 2020/2021, 2021/2022). If no previous league average, the entrant shall use the highest current league average of 21 games or more as of the opening date of the tournament. If current average is 10 pins or higher than the previous season average, the bowler will be required to use the higher of the two averages. If no average, entrant must bowl scratch. An entrant is responsible for verifying the accuracy of the average. Rule 319E: A bowler shall adjust his/her entering average if, during the 12-month period immediately preceding the time and date of bowling, the bowler's accumulated average for all, but not less than 21 tournament games, exceeds the average to be used for entry by **10 or more pins**. In that case, the accumulated average must be used for handicapping or classification purposes. USBC Rule 319A, 319D, 319C and 201 will be enforced. Violation of these rules will result in disqualification.
- All prizes will be returned 100% and will be paid on 1:4 basis. Champions will receive jackets or cash equivalent.

**7. Prize money will be added to the tournament based on the total number of participants: 26-50: \$150.00, 51-75: \$225.00, 76-100: \$300.00, 101-125: \$375.00, 126-150: \$450.00, 151-175: \$525.00, 176 and up: \$600.**

- All bowlers should be aware of the USBC bowling ball specification rule (Chapter 8 Rule 6 B1 shall apply)
- Entries close 30 minutes prior to the start of each shift.. **Pre-registration is required or a walk-in fee of \$5.00 will be charged per person. Walk-ins are accepted based on lane availability.**
- USBC Rule 322a: A player or team missing one or more frames by not being present and ready to bowl in turn shall: begin play with the score to count from the frame then being bowled and will receive zeros for any frames missed.
- Additional squads may be added if deemed necessary by the tournament management.
- Tournament Management reserves the right to reject any entrant whose conduct during the course of the tournament is deemed to be detrimental to the game of bowling.
